- 3) Social Studies Curriculum maps

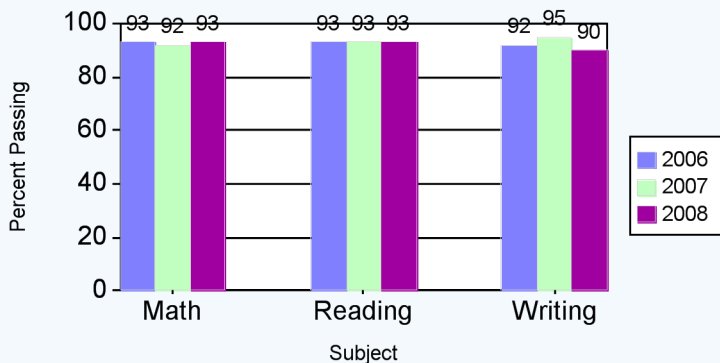

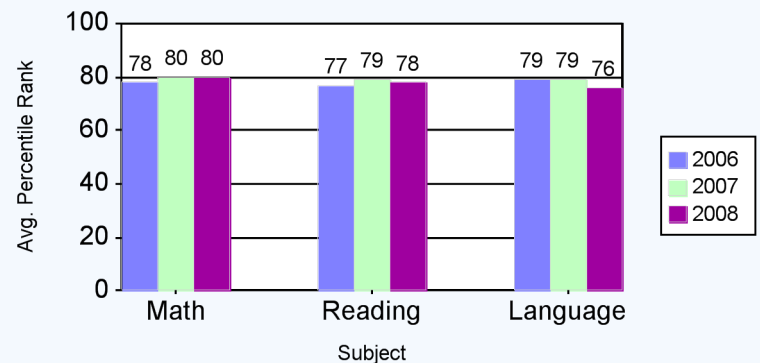
